Baxter Innovation Lab Usage Agreement and Waiver of Liability

The Baxter Innovation Lab at CLC requires users to be trained properly, to follow lab safety and operations protocol when using it, and to accept the risk of using the lab. In order to use the lab, you must acknowledge and agree to the following:

- I will follow the safety rules, procedures, and protocol for the lab described by the lab staff
- I will not use equipment that I have not been trained on or feel unprepared to use safely
- I will use the lab only with an instructor or lab attendant present and never alone
- I am aware the lab uses video surveillance for safety reasons and to prevent theft
- I will follow directions of the CLC staff and CLC volunteer instructors
- I will check in electronically when using the lab
- For personal projects, I understand I can't store my project in the lab due to limited space
- I understand that failure to use the lab and operate the equipment safely may result in (1) loss of access to the equipment and (2) my obligation to reimburse CLC for any damage to the equipment.
- I will not produce or work on projects prohibited by CLC:
 1. Those prohibited by local, state, or federal law;
 2. Those that are unsafe, harmful, and dangerous or pose a threat to the well-being of others including but not limited to weapons;
 3. Projects that contribute to a hostile academic or work environment, including those considered sexually explicit or otherwise offensive as determined by CLC, in its sole discretion;
 4. Project that are in violation of another's intellectual property rights;
 5. Projects intended to be sold for profit
- I understand there are inherent risks associated with the use of the Baxter Innovation Lab classroom and equipment. I hereby assume full responsibility for any and all damages, loss or injuries to Property, Employees or Students of the College of Lake County, to the extent arising from my use of the Baxter Innovation Lab classroom and/or equipment.
