This system uses the ALT/OPTION key on the Mac keyboard (between the Control & Apple keys).

On any mobile device, tap any vowel (cap or small) or the letter **n**, hold for a few seconds. **All accent options will appear on the screen.** Choose the one that you need and it will show up in your text. This is the case for n or N.
