

Lakeshore continues going through a tremendous renovation effort.

The expansion is creating a vibrant urban campus environment with mutually beneficial experiences between the college, students and community we serve.

The new Student Center will bring over 62K square feet of new space dedicated to providing:

- Tutoring center
- Laboratories
- Study spaces

The Student Center will also house the Eleanor Murkey Community Center, located on the top floor with an outstanding outdoor balcony overlooking Lake Michigan where nearly 300 people can gather.

Supporting students with technology needs

When the pandemic forced classes to go virtual, the college stepped up with extra technology resources to keep students on track with their education and working towards career goals. Since the pandemic began, CLC has loaned out more than 700 laptops, 400 hot spots and 200 TI-84 calculators.

\$2.7 million has been helping transform Lake County through quality CLC education. The funds, provided through the Illinois Community College Board's Workforce Equity Initiative Grant, have enabled more than 200 students to enroll in one of many programs including Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC), Engineering Technology, Auto Collision Repair and Truck Driving. The grant has also allowed the college to make investments in new equipment and technology, providing students with experience in demand by Lake County employers. Thank you to Representative Rita Mayfield and the Illinois Legislative Black Caucus for supporting this allocation to CLC.





