Southlake this fall*

Launching fall 2021, the 11-month pharmacy technician certificate program will prepare students to face the challenges of a quickly evolving career field while also helping employers fill a growing demand for the position. The Bureau of Labor Statistics predicts the field will grow by four percent over the next decade. However, CLC's Pharmacy Technician and Chemistry instructor Dr. Derek Leiter, who has been in the pharmacy field for 15 years, believes it will be much higher.

CLC is focused on creating more short-term certificates like this one with high-value impact for our students and the communities we serve.





