1. Complete an application for admission into the university with a major in Criminal Justice
2. Carthage is NOT a participant in the IAI. All courses will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.
3. Students with less than 12 college level credit hrs must submit official high school transcripts including ACT or SAT scores.
