This transfer guide is designed to assist students with their academic planning. Every effort is made to maintain accurate information; however, this information is subject to frequent change. Students should contact the member institution to keep informed of changes, as final responsibility for verifying information rests with the student.

TRANSFER OPTIONS

- Completed AA or AS degree: IAI GECC fulfills general education requirements. Major courses will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.
- Completed IAI GECC: IAI GECC fulfills general education requirements.
- Completing some courses at CLC: If transferring with 30+ credit hours from CLC, the student is eligible for the IAI GECC, which can be completed at CCC. If transferring with less than 30 credit hours, courses will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.

TRANSFER CREDITS

Up to 75 hours are accepted from community colleges, AP, military, CLEP, and credit for life experience. Columbia will not accept "C minus" or lower grades in transfer, except for IAI GECC courses. **Core Course equivalencies** can be found at: transferology.com

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Columbia College offers exceptional educational programs in the visual, performing, media and communication arts. Students with creative ability in those areas, as well as students who have a strong yet undeveloped interest in these areas, are invited to apply for admission.

- Requires: application with essay, high school and college transcript(s), and \$35 non-refundable application fee. Letter of recommendation is recommended but not required.
- Submission of ACT/SAT scores is not required, but is encouraged.
- There is no minimum required number of transfer hours. If applicant has successfully complete 24 or more College credit hours with posted final grades since graduating high school, they can complete a high school verification form and CCC will remove the high school transcript requirement.
