TRANSFER OPTIONS

- Completed AA or AS degree: IAI GECC fulfills general education requirements. Major courses will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.
- Completed IAI GECC: IAI GECC fulfills general education requirements.
- Completing some courses at CLC: If transferring with 30+ credit hours from CLC, the student is eligible for the IAI GECC, which can be completed at CCC. If transferring with less than 30 credit hours, courses will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.

TRANSFER CREDITS

Up to 75 hours are accepted from all colleges, universities, AP, military, CLEP, and credit for life experience. Minimum C grade in ENG 121 & 122 and major coursework required; D grade accepted for general education with completed IAI GECC and minimum 2.0 GPA. **Course equivalencies** can be found at transferology.com

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Columbia College offers exceptional educational programs in the visual, performing, media, business, and communication arts. Students with creative ability in those areas, as well as students who have a strong yet undeveloped interest in these areas, are invited to apply for admission. There are no required coursework or minimum transfer hours.

- Requires: application with two brief essays, official college transcript(s), and \$50 non-refundable application fee. High school transcripts are required for applicants who have earned under 24 college-level credits.
 - If an applicant has successfully completed 24 or more college credit hours since graduating high school, they can complete a high school verification form and CCC will not require a high school transcript.
- Strongly recommended: Official ACT/SAT scores and/or a letter of recommendation. Digital portfolios and/or video auditions are not required for admission.
