This transfer guide is designed to assist students with their academic planning. Every effort is made to maintain accurate information; however, this information is subject to frequent change. Students should contact the member institution to keep informed of changes, as final responsibility for verifying information rests with the student.

### TRANSFER OPTIONS

- **Completed AA Degree:** CLC students will be evaluated to have met all lower division general education requirements with the exception of any mission specific courses and receive junior status. Individual majors may have additional prerequisites and/or requirements that are not covered by this agreement.
- **IAI GECC:** Completing *only* the IAI General Education Core at CLC (no AA) will be evaluated by Concordia as completing the lower division general education requirements with the exception of any mission specific courses. Individual majors may have additional prerequisites and/or requirements that are not covered by this agreement.
- **Completing some courses at CLC:** If transferring prior to completing the IAI General Education Core at CLC, students will be evaluated on a course by course basis.

### TRANSFER CREDITS

The maximum number of semester hours transferable from a community college to meet Concordia graduation requirements is 67.

**Course equivalencies:** Students may set up an appointment for a free credit evaluation.

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum GPA is a cumulative 2.0 from all colleges attended.
- Transfers with 15 semester hours or more: submit an application and official college transcripts for each institution attended.
- Transfers with fewer than 15 semester hours completed: submit an ACT or SAT score and a final high school transcript with graduation date or written documentation of successful completion of the G.E.D. and official college transcripts for each institution attended. An official high school transcript is also required if the college from which credit was earned does not have full regional accreditation.

### CALCULATION OF ADMISSION GPA

Concordia will calculate the GPA based on the CLC transcript and the transcripts of any additional institutions attended for admission purposes.

### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

- For the 2018-19 academic year, incoming transfer students will be eligible for renewable, merit-based awards and scholarships ranging from \$5,000 to \$15,000.
- Phi Theta Kappa- \$2,000; Renewable award given to students who are members of Phi Theta Kappa. Verification must be provided.
- Church Professional Grant - Award amounts vary; Requirements: Provide annual verification of intent to pursue a church profession
- Music Scholarships: Based on audition

### **SPECIAL NOTES**

- Can accept up to 67 semester hours of credit from CLC to help you maintain your academic and financial aid status.
- Courses listed on the transfer planning guides are preferred; however, credit may be accepted for courses not listed. Contact a Concordia transfer counselor for more specific information.
- If you plan to take additional courses in your major or elective credit, contact Concordia transfer counselor for assistance.
- Concordia accepts CLEP credit; however, the credit varies by score. See the Concordia University catalog for more specific information.
