### ACADEMIC PROGRAMS AVAILABLE

As a College of Lake County (CLC)-DePaul Admission Partnership Program participant, international students may be eligible for approximately 97 DePaul undergraduate programs and majors. The most popular programs selected by international students are: finance, business administration, marketing, accounting and computer science. ### PROGRAM FEATURES

#### Intensive English Language Program:

Complete CLC's Intensive English Language Program (ELI), if needed.

**Year 1 & 2:** Successfully complete an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree program at CLC as a DAPP participant.\* Students must join DAPP prior to earning 30 semester hours at College of Lake County in their academic degree program.

**Year 3 & 4:** Successfully complete a Bachelor's degree program at DePaul University.

*\*Students must earn a minimum cumulative 2.0 grade point average (GPA) in their Associate's degree to be admitted into DePaul University. Students must have earned 2.5 GPA to enter majors in DePaul's Driehaus College of Business and College of Education.*

# A GUARANTEED ADMISSION PROGRAM FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS.

College of Lake County (CLC) international students who participate in the College of Lake County–DePaul Admission Partnership Program (DAPP) are guaranteed admission to DePaul University provided that all current admissions standards, policies and procedures of DePaul are met at the time of admission.

### FEATURES AND BENEFITS TO INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- Gain English language proficiency in College of Lake County's Intensive English Language Program (ELI), if needed.
- Earn both an associate's degree and a bachelor's degree from two quality institutions.
- Receive assistance in planning your DePaul bachelor's degree as early as your first semester in your academic degree college credit courses at College of Lake County (CLC). Benefits of DAPP include:
  - Credits you complete at CLC will apply to both CLC associate degree and DePaul bachelor's degree.
  - General education and program requirements will not change during your CLC degree program, once you have selected your DePaul program.
  - Meeting regularly with a DePaul transfer admission counselor who will help you select courses and provide you with progress reports on your degree plan.
  - Invitations to DAPP presentations, workshops and activities for DePaul transfer students.
  - The DAPP scholarship is automatically awarded to qualified DAPP students who have a cumulative transfer 3.0 GPA. Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) scholarships will be awarded to qualified international transfer students.

### REQUIREMENTS FOR DAPP GUARANTEED ADMISSION

**Step 1:** Gain admission to CLC and tell your counselor that you want to transfer to DePaul University after completing your associate degree at Lake County.

**Step 2:** Meet with your CLC counselor to verify enrollment records and tell them you want to participate in DAPP, prior to earning 30 semester hours at College of Lake County in your academic degree program.

**Step 3:** Submit the DePaul University online transfer application indicating your interest in attending DePaul, during your first year of transfer degree college credit enrollment at CLC.

**Step 4:** Meet with DePaul University Transfer Admission Counselor each semester to select your program and create a degree plan.

**Step 5:** Successfully complete an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree at College of Lake County. Achieve a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) at CLC as follows:

- 2.5 GPA for programs in the Driehaus College of Business or DePaul's College of Education.
- 2.0 GPA for all other DePaul Colleges and undecided programs.
- English proficiency requirement is waived when you complete CLC's ENG 121 and ENG 122 with grades of C or better.

**Step 6:** Finalize your application to DePaul University one term before you are ready to begin your studies at DePaul. Submit all of your final official transcripts. Provide documentation of PTK participation to receive PTK scholarship, if eligible.

*NOTE: If you have university credit from outside the United States you must submit a course-by-course evaluation completed by Educational Perspectives ([www.edperspectives.org/depaul](http://www.edperspectives.org/depaul)), Educational Credential Evaluators ([www.ece.org](http://www.ece.org)) or One Earth International Credential Evaluations ([http://www.oneearthevaluations.org/One\\_Earth/DePaul\\_University.html](http://www.oneearthevaluations.org/One_Earth/DePaul_University.html)). You will need to fill out an application on their website, pay the evaluation fee and submit all required educational credentials as described on their website.*
