ADMISSION TO TEACHER EDUCATION

Attend University Admission to Teacher Education meeting and submit formal application for University Admission to Teacher Education. Recommended to attend early, up to a year prior to enrollment. - Establish and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.65 at Eastern Illinois University.
- ALL Teacher Education Programs REQUIRE a minimum grade of "C" in all courses required for a program (all general education courses and courses required by the major). This is in accordance with the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) certification policy.
