Admission Requirements

- Cumulative GPA of **3.0** or higher by the end of the sophomore year. GPA must be at least 3.2 to remain in the program and enroll in 300/400-level courses. See the College catalog for additional requirements.
- Grade of B or higher in ENG 121 and 122 (CLC course numbers) is required for admission to program.
- Students must pass the Test of Academic Proficiency (formerly Basic Skills) or have an ACT plus Writing score of at least 22 or an SAT score of at least 1030 before registering for CSD 378 – see the Department of Education for more information.
- Requirements for Licensure from the Illinois State Board of Education include master's degree in speech-language pathology and EED 223 - Education of PK-12 Learners with Exceptionalities (course must be completed at Elmhurst College).
