TRANSFER OPTIONS

- **Completed AA or AS degree:** CLC students will be evaluated to have met all lower division University Core Curriculum requirements for general graduation purposes at SIU Carbondale and receive junior status. Individual majors may have additional prerequisites and/or requirements that are not covered by this agreement.
- **IAI GECC:** Completing *only* the IAI General Education Core at CLC (no AA/AS) will be evaluated by SIU as completing the lower division University Core Curriculum requirements for general graduation purposes. Individual majors may have additional prerequisites and/or requirements that are not covered by this agreement.
- **Completing some courses at CLC:** Students who have earned 30 hours of transferable, IAI credit are eligible have the option to complete either the IAI GECC after transfer or SIU's University Core Curriculum requirements. Students should check with an SIU advisor to determine the best option.

TRANSFER CREDITS

There is no set maximum number of hours transferable from a community college. However, to meet SIU's graduation requirements, the transfer student must have earned 42 semester hours at the 300-400 level from a four-year institution (beginning with the 2013-2014 catalog) and the last 30 semester hours at SIU. SIU will accept courses with grades of "D" for some Core Curriculum course requirements. A grade of "C" or higher must be achieved in English 121 and 122 and some major courses.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 26 transferable semester credit hours with a 2.0/4.0 GPA as calculated by SIU and eligibility to continue enrollment at the last institution attended.
- Students with less than 26 hours must meet freshman admission requirements and submit ACT or SAT scores and an official high school transcript.

- Special requirements exist for those seeking direct entry into certain majors and CAPSTONE options - SEE "Selective Screening Majors."

CALCULATION OF ADMISSION GPA

- SIU recalculates the transfer student GPA for admission purposes. GPA is based on SIU's grading policies and procedures and on the basis of work from all previous, regionally-accredited colleges attended. Developmental coursework is not included.
- See the SIU Undergraduate Catalog, <https://catalog.siu.edu/> for the repeat grade policy. Note: **Effective for courses taken summer 2013 or later**, only the most recent (last) grade will be calculated in the overall GPA and count toward hours earned. This policy will be applied to all transferable credit in that only the last grade will be used to calculate grade point average. Only those courses taken at the same institution are considered repeats under this policy.
- If a student has earned an AA/AS degree from CLC, and SIU's grading calculations cause the student's GPA to fall below a 2.0, he/she will still be admitted as long as the student has not taken any additional college work since graduating from CLC.

APPLICATION

Rolling Admissions but Preferred Deadlines are one year in advance of entry

Several programs require application one year in advance.

The following programs do NOT accept transfer students for the Spring terms:

Architectural Studies, Dental Hygiene, Fashion Design and Merchandising, Interior Design, Physical Therapist Assistant, Radiologic Sciences

SELECTIVE SCREENING MAJORS :

Architectural Studies, Automotive Technology, Aviation Flight, Aviation Management, Business and Administration (online program), College of Engineering majors, Dental Hygiene, Music, Physical Therapy Assistant, Public Safety Management (off-campus program) and Radiologic Sciences.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

College of Liberal Arts requires 2 semesters of the same foreign language for graduation for most majors. Radio, Television, and Digital Media major requires 2 semesters of the same foreign language for graduation.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Students are encouraged to complete the application for admission one year in advance to be competitive for merit-based scholarships. GPA includes all colleges attended (not just CLC GPA).

- Dean's Transfer Scholarship: 3.5 GPA as calculated by SIU; completed 30 transferable semester hours. \$4,000 each year for two years.
- Phi Theta Kappa Award: recipient of the Dean's Transfer Scholarship and member of PTK for at least one year. \$3,000 one-time award (five awarded), and may be in addition to the Dean's Transfer Scholarship.

SPECIAL NOTES

- SIU offers a Capstone degree for students who have earned an AAS degree.
- SIU accepts CLEP credit; students are asked to contact SIU's Department of Articulation and Evaluation at 618-453-2012 for more detailed info.
- Truth in Tuition: SIU will apply the Truth in Tuition Bill to transfer students. The tuition a transfer student pays will be frozen for four consecutive years from the matriculation term at SIUC. The accompanying fees and cost of living on-campus will not be frozen.
