Transfer Planning Guide – SECONDARY EDUCATION MAJORS

Use in tandem with the UIUC general transfer guide

- The Secondary Education option in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS) includes content work in your major and professional education courses in the College of Education. In order to be considered for the Secondary Education minor, you must enter with one of the following majors: **Biology (IB or MCB), Chemistry, English, Geology, History, Math or Physics**. - All courses in **bold** must be completed prior to transfer; General Education are recommended to be completed prior to transfer.
- Students are required to **pass the Illinois Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP)** as an admission criterion. Test scores must be submitted by time of application. For fall admission consideration, applicants should take this test during the fall prior to the year of application. Additional info: <http://www.icts.nesinc.com/>. ACT Plus Writing/SAT scores can be used in lieu of a passing score on the Test of Academic Proficiency. - Tutoring requirement:** Complete 50 hours of verified academic tutoring experience with middle school or high school students before the application deadline of February 1st. MAJOR REQUIREMENTS	
courses in bold must be completed prior to transfer Required: GPA of 2.7	
MAJOR	COURSES
Biology	Composition I; CMM 121; Foreign Language; BIO 161, 162; CHM 121 and 123; CHM 222; EDU 121, 225; ESC 121, 141; MTH 145; MTH 222; PSY 121 This is a five-year program. Transfer students first apply to Integrative Biology major in LAS. During the spring semester at UIUC (by Feb. 1), students apply to the Secondary Education Minor after completing additional required courses.
Chemistry	Composition I; CMM 121; Foreign Language; CHM 121 and 123; CHM 222; EDU 121, 225; MTH 145, 146, 246; PSY 121; PHY 123, 124 This is a five-year program. Additional required course (UIUC CHEM 222) is not available at CLC.
English	Composition I; CMM 121; Foreign Language; EDU 121, 225; ENG 223, 229; HST 221, 222; PSY 121 Note: No CLC equivalent for UIUC's required ENGL 200 and 301. Student need to apply to LAS as an English Major, take these at UIUC before applying to the Secondary Education Minor in the College of Education.
Foreign Language	Composition I; CMM 121; EDU 121, 225; HST (221 or 222); PSC 121; PSY 121; 4 years high school or through 222 at CLC (same language); 223 and 224 level courses in your language of study
Geology (Earth Science)	Composition I; CMM 121; Foreign Language; BIO 161; CHM 121, 123; ESC 121, 127, 140; EDU 121, 225; MTH 145; PHY 121 and 122; PSY 121
History	Composition I; CMM 121; Foreign Language; EDU 121, 225; Choose 2 from HST 121, 122, 221, 222; MTH 142 or 222; PSC 121; PSY 121; SOC 121; GEG 122; PSC 221; ECO 221, 222
Mathematics	Composition I; CMM 121; Foreign Language; EDU 121, 225; MCS (140 or 141) or CIT 134; MTH 145, 146, 246; PSY 121. Note: Students must have completed UIUC Math 347 plus two additional advanced math courses at the time they apply to the Math Teaching Option. Since most community colleges, including CLC, do not offer enough advanced math courses, students will need to be in attendance at UIUC for one year prior to application to the teaching option. If a student completes Calc I & II freshman year, sophomore transfer is recommended.
Physics (3.0 GPA for tech subjects)	Composition I; CMM 121; Foreign Language; CHM 121 and 123; EDU 121, 225; MTH 145, 146, 246, 227; PHY 123, 124, 221; PSY 121 Students will need additional advanced math courses that are not available at CLC; therefore, students will need a year in attendance at UIUC prior to application to the Physics Teaching Option.

When selecting the General Education courses, consider that the Major Requirements above meet some of the General Education areas.

Composition I	(ENG 120 and (122 or 126)) OR (ENG 121 and (122 or 126))
Advanced Comp.	Must be taken at UIUC
Foreign Language	There is no foreign language requirement for transfer admission. For graduation, students will need to complete through 4 years in high school or through the 4 th semester in college. Eligible courses are listed on the Campus Wide list. <u>Completing the Foreign language requirement for graduation is strongly encouraged before transfer.</u>
Humanities & the Arts: 6 hours	Social & Behavioral Sciences: 6 hours
Natural Sciences and Technology: 6 hours	Non-Western Cultures: one course
Quantitative Reasoning I: one course	Western Cultures: one course
Quantitative Reasoning I or II: one course	U.S. Minority Cultures: one course
