### TRANSFER OPTIONS

In most cases having completed an AA/AS degree at CLC meets UW-Milwaukee's general education requirements (outside of the UWM's cultural diversity and foreign language requirements for graduation). The cultural diversity requirement is three credits in a course relating to the study of life experiences of African Americans, Hispanic/Latino Americans, American Indians or Asian Americans.

Please contact the transfer admissions representative listed above to verify completion, as UWM's general education requirements are not automatically waived by completing an AA/AS degree at CLC. General Education requirements can be viewed in detail in the UWM catalog:

### TRANSFER CREDITS

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Transfer students must have a minimum cumulative college transfer GPA of 2.0.
- No credit minimum required for admission.
- Certain majors at UW-M have GPA requirements for acceptance into the major. Check the UW-M Schools and Colleges website to learn more about specifics about requirements.

### CALCULATION OF ADMISSION GPA

UW-M will use the cumulative GPA from the CLC transcript. Course grades of 'F' are included in the transfer GPA and are accepted in transfer (no credit is earned for the F grade); if a course is retaken the most recent grade is transferred.

## APPLICATION

## FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

Students who have at least 2 years of the same foreign language from high school or who have 2 semesters of the same foreign language from CLC have met their foreign language requirement for their bachelor's degree from UW-M. Students who do not fall under this exemption must complete the Foreign Language requirement at UW-M.

## TUITION/SCHOLARSHIPS

- **Midwest Student Exchange Program (MSEP):** Students are charged 150% of the in-state tuition rate. No application is required. All students are eligible.
- **General Scholarships:** UW-Milwaukee offers variety of scholarship opportunities for transfer students. Please visit [www.scholarships.uwm.edu](http://www.scholarships.uwm.edu) to learn how you can apply for them.
- **Milwaukee Advantage Program:** All students from Illinois, who are admitted to UW-Milwaukee, will also receive a \$1,000 scholar award on top of the discount from the MSEP program
