

Western IL University Transfer Planning Guide – NURSING MAJOR

Use in tandem with WIU general transfer guide

The [Pre-Licensure](#) Program is for students who have met all the general education and nursing support course requirements and who wish to study nursing. Pre licensure program is available on the Macomb Campus only. For more information: <http://www.wiu.edu/nursing/> or email: nursing@wiu.edu

Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0., and have a minimum nursing support courses GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale with a grade of C+ (2.33) or better. In addition, only one of these nursing support courses may be repeated if a grade of C+ (2.33) is not achieved. A student may repeat one course one time. Admission will be denied to any student who received a second grade of less than C+ (2.33) for any nursing support course.

These courses must be successfully completed before a student will be accepted into the nursing program.

Note: WIU's foreign language/global issues graduation requirement may be fulfilled by successfully completing NURS 316 at WIU.

Acceptance into the BSN Program (Nursing major) involves three stages;

- **Stage One:** Admission to Western Illinois University
- **Stage Two:** Have a completed application on file with the Nursing Centralized Application Service (Nursing CAS) no later than March 1 for admission to the next Fall semester and October 1 for admission to Spring semester.
- **Stage Three:** Complete general education and nursing support course requirements by August 1 for Fall semester or January 2 for Spring semester.
- **Stage Four:** Formal Application to the Nursing Major Degree Program
