Documents needed to complete 24-25 FAFSA or Alternative Application

- For FAFSA completion, please have your FSA ID and password ready, as well as that of any of your contributors.
- Your Social Security number if you have not created an FSA ID (it's essential to enter it correctly on the FAFSA form!)
- Your driver's license number, if you have one
- 2022 Federal tax information, tax documents, or tax returns, including IRS W-2 information, for you (and your spouse, if you are married) and for your parents if you are a dependent student.
- Records of your untaxed income, such as child support received, interest income, and veterans noneducation benefits, for you and your parents if you are a dependent student.
- Information on cash; savings and checking account balances; investments, including stocks and bonds and real estate (but not including the home in which you live); and business and farm assets for you and your parents if you are a dependent student.
