

## State of Illinois COVID-19 Executive Order #88 Fact Sheet for Noncredit Students

### What is it?

On September 3, 2021, Governor Pritzker issued COVID-19 Executive Order #88. It contains directives around mandatory face coverings and vaccination and testing requirements for higher education.

### Who does it apply to?

It applies to higher education personnel and students/community members enrolled at higher education institutions who attend class on-campus or at an affiliated off-campus location. It does not apply to students enrolled only in online classes.

### When is it in effect?

Beginning September 19, 2021, all students/community members enrolled in classes held on-campus or at an affiliated off-campus location must submit documentation that they are fully vaccinated **or** be tested for COVID-19 weekly until they are fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Students/community members who are not fully vaccinated and who do not certify they have been tested for COVID-19 by the weekly deadline will not be able to access campus or attend their class at an affiliated off-campus location for the upcoming week.

A person is **fully vaccinated** against COVID-19 two weeks after receiving the second dose in a two-dose series of a COVID-19 vaccine authorized for emergency use, licensed, or otherwise approved by the FDA, **or** two weeks after receiving a single-dose COVID-19 vaccine authorized for emergency use, licensed, or otherwise approved by the FDA.

### Where does it apply?

It applies to the College of Lake County Grayslake, Vernon Hills and Waukegan campuses, and any affiliated off-campus location where CLC classes are offered.

Please note: Extended interactions in-person on campus for students/community members who are not vaccinated or who do not submit their weekly testing certification will not be allowed. These individuals will be referred to alternate options such as virtual appointments or assistance by phone/email.

### Why has it been enacted?

To protect the health and safety of Illinoisans by mitigating the spread of the COVID-19 virus and to increase the number of vaccinated individuals.

### How do I comply?

If you registered through learn.clcillinois.edu and your user name resembles this format X000001, follow these steps:

You will receive an email from [no-reply@cleared4work.com](mailto:no-reply@cleared4work.com) with a unique, personal link. After logging in, follow the step-by-step instructions.

If you are <b>fully vaccinated</b> against COVID-19...	Submit your proof of vaccination online through your unique, personal Cleared4 link.
If you are <b>in the process</b> of being fully vaccinated...	Continue to submit your weekly testing confirmation through your unique, personal Cleared4 link until you are fully vaccinated. Then, submit your proof of vaccination online through your unique, personal Cleared4 link.

If you <b>would like</b> to get vaccinated...	Visit one of our <a href="#">free, drop-in vaccination events</a> or get vaccinated in your community.  Continue to submit your weekly testing confirmation through your unique, personal Cleared4 link until you are fully vaccinated. Then, submit your proof of vaccination online through your unique, personal Cleared4 link.

If you <b>cannot or do not want</b> to get vaccinated...	Continue to submit your weekly testing confirmation through your unique, personal Cleared4 link through the end of your class. This requirement will stay in place until the Governor announces changes to his executive order. Continue to monitor the <a href="#">COVID-19 website</a> for updated information.

If you <b>would like</b> to get vaccinated...	Visit one of our <a href="#">free, drop-in vaccination events</a> or get vaccinated in your community.  Continue to submit your weekly testing confirmation at <a href="#">www.clcillinois.edu/weeklytest</a> until you are fully vaccinated. Then, submit your proof of vaccination online at <a href="http://www.clcillinois.edu/vax1">www.clcillinois.edu/vax1</a>
